## A GIFT OF THE HEART / TZEDAKAH

Temple Sholom welcomes all who wish to join our community! We have a long tradition of offering engagement and connection through worship, education, and justice programs. Most importantly we hope to provide spiritual support to all within our congregation. Over the past year we have worked especially hard to expand our reach to the community at large and grow our synagogue.

We operate from a place of abundance and believe that people are what move our congregation forward. In keeping with this, we ask for a *voluntary* contribution, **A Gift of the Heart**. This is an amount of *your* choosing to sustain the spiritual and fiscal strength of Temple Sholom. While there is a fiscal reality to running our organization, finances should never prevent anyone from being a part of our community. Our doors are open to all!

As indicated in the graphic accompanying this letter, our annual Gifts of the Heart and additional pledges represent about 51% of our income this year. The remainder comes from grants, sponsorships, programming, religious school and other donations. Certain fundraising efforts like our Annual High Holiday Appeal help us to assure our budget is sound.

To guide you in setting your gift, we are providing an amount that is determined (after pulling out grant money and other income) to operate the Temple without a deficit, which is our ultimate goal. This year it is \$2,000. This is <u>NOT</u> dues in sheep's clothing. Rather, it offers transparency into what it takes to sustain our Temple community, allowing each member to connect on their terms and at all stages of life; creating a shared covenant of success.

We know that for some households the suggested gift amount may be out of reach. For others, it may fit perfectly. Still, for others, it may be a starting point for how much they are able to contribute to Temple Sholom. And while these annual gifts do allow us to plan better for programming and other Temple needs and efforts, we also understand if now is not the right time for you to make a financial commitment. We understand and respect your decision.
